

An event of the year OH WHAT A NIGHT

On Saturday 7th September, after weeks of preparation and graft an excited crowd streamed into Havant's Pallant Centre for the Langstone Village Association's ever-popular annual Trad Jazz night.

And they weren't disappointed when Chris Newman's Georgia Ramblers filled the proscenium stage and proved once and for all, you can't beat an evening of live music, especially when it's at the exciting pace and rhythm of Trad Jazz from New Orleans.

The traditional line up of Trumpet, trombone, clarinet, keyboards, drums and sousaphone soon got under way with toe-tapping classics that got a large crowd quickly and joyously onto the floor, jiving, dancing, smooching and even doing the Charleston with wild abandon. Indeed, "Running Wild" a song from Marilyn Monroe's film **Some Like it Hot**, could have been the theme for the evening and proved an extra winner at the end, as the crowd demanded and shrieked for an encore and got it!

You could have said that this wasn't typical Langstone behaviour and you'd be right. There were new faces in the audience – young and old – some having travelled to Havant from as far as field as Liphook and Basingstoke and even Kent. Obviously, the appeal of LVA events is reaching way beyond the village it represents.

After a dynamic interval spot from Cannon Tom Kinnar playing and singing exceptional Blues and Jazz typified with a soulful "Stormy Monday Blues", the band reassembled on stage for what has become a much loved tradition the New Orleans Umbrella Parade and the audience were well prepared and up for it.

The moment Chris Newman announced they were to play "Bourbon Street Parade", a sea of bobbing, colourful decorated umbrellas opened up and the audience twirled and shook them with abandon. They danced and marched the length and breadth of the Pallant, expertly led by amazing Mike Skiffins as marshal, in hiss full New Orleans regalia. And 90 year young Pat Carr from Southsea ably assisted by her son David also sprang into action from her wheelchair. Bandleader Chris Newman said that outside of New Orleans, he had never seen so many umbrellas brandished with such joy!

The Monkey song from the film Jungle Book, "I Wanna Be Like You", excited more frenzied dancing, as did "12 Street Rag" along with the Charleston which got everyone moving wildly and stretching limbs to the limits. Throughout the evening, Chris Newman was able to give context to many of the numbers; the history of the music (going back to the 1890's and the evolution from the spirituals, ragtime, and Blues) as well as telling us about some of the unique characters who played it originally – King Oliver, Jelly Roll Morton, Louis 'Satchmo' Armstrong, Kid Ory and Fats Waller.
