SHOP TALK (What's new if anything?)

In Decembers issue I wrote about the new shop move to West Street, Fareham, which has proved very popular with local musicians who had never used Havant Music Mart, or Happy in Basepoint, Waterlooville. The new shop is in a far better trading position, even better for most of my regular customers, with a better amount of car parking and near the railway station and bus station. Sadly the size of the shop has shrunk, but the amount of stock on offer has not, a lot no longer on display, but this is not proving to be a problem. Since I have always run my shops as a general music retailer rather than just a guitar shop! The range in product is wider, since the vast area of instruments.

Since opening here I have introduced a new range of Enya Guitars and Ukuleles, which have a modern touch to them, and priced competitively. These Enya instruments have the Acoustic Plus system which allows players to add sound effects from the instrument itself, with no external devices needed. They come with a carry bag and accessories plus you can connect to the computer. Well worth checking out. Also HMM has now added the Snail Ukulele range which are proving very popular, along with the brands we already stock, Kala, Mahalo, Blackwater, Barnes & Mullins, Laka. We also carry a large range of accessories to help keep you playing. Another product just in is the Isuzi Performer Series AA-2 25 watt Acoustic amplifier with Lithium Battery at £269.99 which is ideal for Electro Guitar or Ukulele. Plus there is a Speaker stand top hat fitted so you can raise it above crowd level.

The new range of Bromo Acoustic guitars is proving to be very popular, with the solid top Electro acoustics starting at £199.99. The Bromo Rocky Mountain Series Parlour Guitar priced at £335.00 has rave reviews in the USA and UK as brilliant value for money, check it out! The range of SX electric guitars and bass's are well made and at competitive prices, worth checking out along with the Cort acoustic and electric guitars, which have both proved to be good sellers in the Christmas period.

If your having guitar lead problems, we give a free lead test service, and our Boston brand leads 3mtr at £9.99 (listed at £13.99) is excellent value. Remember to pull the lead out by the plug, don't yank the lead out or tread on them, a good lead will last you for years!! Our best selling instrument strings are Rotosound, the electric's have a free top 'e' (the thinnest, which always is the first to break) and the Jumbo King acoustic strings have a good ring to them, British made and at a competitive price. We also stock D'addario which are an American string maker, and keep an across the range of their strings.

Another new range we have started to stock are the Mahalo Laptop Cajons which also come with a carry bag, these offer an easy way to enhance your percussion band or add another layer to your performance. Many of the ukulele groups could well find this an added instrument. These Cajons can be played solo or to accompany other instruments, it's thye perfect hand drum to grab for any playing or practice situation. We also stock the Mahalo Kalimba's which come with a carry bag.

Bored, looking for a challenge, remember what ever instrument you buy, you will have fun learning to play it, it could change your life.....

Spike Milligan was a genius of British Comedy, for five decades he was to be one of this country's most influential comics and inspire enormous affection in his many listners, viewers and readers. The first significant tragedy of Spike's life came at the end of an idyllic childhood in India when his family moved to foggy, depression ridden London. (not alots changed then!!) His personality which could be a difficult, contradictory and misanthropic as it was passionate, sensitive and inspired. In the 1950's he was a large part of the new voice in comedy with The Goons, film and television, his books and stage shows. Since his death in February 2002, there have been many books written about him and his amazing life, about his struggle with his bouts of depression, he was a true all round human being.

His grave stone reads "I told you I was ill". He was a man of many things.....
